

ARMS COMMUNITY-WIDE PARTNERSHIPS

- UAB SuperFund Research Studies focuses on improving the health of the residents in the North Birmingham community; focusing on asthma, lung health, lead, and arsenic concerns.
- Through the American Heart Association, ARMS partners with the Jones Valley Teaching Farm
 with the Food Rx Program. ARMS patients, who have food insecurities and live in food deserts,
 are provided fresh fruit and vegetables, free of charge. Hypertension patients are also referred
 to the Food Rx Program to improve their blood pressure numbers.
- ARMS partners with Continuum of Care, the Housing Authority of the Birmingham District, and the Jefferson County Housing Authority regarding primary care and housing services for the homeless and all individuals, including persons with physical disabilities, substance use disorders, and behavioral health.
- ARMS provides Prevention Services (free screenings) to individuals of the Church of the Reconciler, the Birmingham Public Library (Central and Smithfield locations), the Dannon Project, and Walgreens for the Annual National HIV Testing Day.
- ARMS partners with Trinity United Methodist Church, Highlands United Methodist Church, First Light Women's & Children's Shelter, and Child Care Resources, in providing primary care services and screenings via our Mobile Health Units.
- ARMS partners with the Worship Center Church Men's Health Summit, UAB's Annual Regional Wellness Day, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity (Alpha Phi Chapter) Annual Health Fair, and the Birmingham/Jefferson County Transit Authority Health Fair.
- ARMS, also, partners with homeless servicing organizations, including Faith Chapel Christian Church, Salvation Army, Community Kitchens, Olivia House, and others.
